



## **Pre-Visit Guidelines for Teachers**

**We value students/teachers attendance at the Springville Museum of Art and are pleased to welcome you. There are some general instructions and guidelines that we would like you to read and discuss with your class before your visit. Understanding these rules will help ensure the success of your activity:**

- **Please do not touch any of the artwork**
- **Please maintain an 18-inch distance from the artwork (this may be noted by the change in tile patterns on the floor)**
- **Keep your group together (It is a good idea for younger children to each have a buddy)**
- **Lead discussion about art in each gallery (see staff if help needed)**
- **1 chaperon for every 10 students**
- **Walk, no running**
- **Use quiet voices**
- **Food or drink only outside the museum**
- **Leave backpacks or water bottles with desk volunteers**
- **Students are welcome to use their pencils in the second floor galleries; however, we request that chaperones hold all pencils when not in use**
